E-Z INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Surfaces must be clean and dry. Cut tip of cartridge and puncture inner foil seal several times (or unscrew tip and cut end).
2. **SETTING TILE:** Apply E-Z Patch® 22 on the back of the tile or on the substrate surface and then set tiles.
3. **GROUTING:** Fill the grout crack or grout joint full and deep with E-Z Patch® 22. Run finger or soft rubber trowel “float” over grout joints for 100% sealing to both sides of grout joint. Submerge the **Scrubber Pad (2 Scrubber Pads are included with E-Z Patch® 22 S.S. and also sold separately = see E-Z Patch® Bulk Scrubbers)** in water, pour some **Liquid Dishwashing Soap** on the Scrubber Pad and immediately scrub off all excess silicone rubber. Any other clean-up may be done with a paper towel and rubbing alcohol or mineral spirits.
4. Do not allow liquid dishwashing soap or water to contact surfaces to be grouted prior to installing silicone rubber.
5. Do not allow Silicone Rubber to skin over before removing any excess with Scrubber Pads (about 1-5 minutes, depending on the temperature).

E-Z ANSWERS to some Frequently Asked Questions

- **Product will flow and cure faster in hotter weather, slower in cooler weather**
- **Product is best stored between 0 and 80 degrees**
- **Silicone Rubber grouting is best done between 50 degrees F and 90 degrees F**
