



POOL CONCRETE AND CANTILEVER EDGE REPAIRS

E-Z INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Remove any loose pieces.
2. Scrub area with water (and soap if needed).
3. Immediately rinse the area thoroughly and allow to dry.
4. **FOR RESETTING PIECES OF EXISTING CONCRETE:** Apply a small amount of E-Z PATCH® 3 (Thinset) and firmly press into place. For a flexible repair use E-Z PATCH 22 Neutral Cure Silicone Rubber but the surfaces must be very dry! Then repair edges or gaps with **E-Z Patch® 6**.
5. Add LIQUID CEMENT BONDER to **E-Z PATCH® 6 DRY CEMENT MIX** (use fractions = $\frac{1}{4}$ of the dry mix to $\frac{1}{4}$ of the liquid cement bonder, etc.). Add water and mix until you get the consistency of very stiff "mashed potatoes". Use warm water for faster set and cold water to slow set.
- 6a. **FOR CANTILEVER EDGE REPAIR:** Firmly apply one thin scratch coat of **E-Z PATCH® 6**. Immediately fill in the area up to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick. If the repair is thicker, wait until first application is stiff, and then apply more **E-Z Patch® 6**. Trowel flat and smooth. Remove excess from edges with a moist sponge.
- 6b. **FOR CHIP REPAIR:** Firmly apply one thin scratch coat of **E-Z PATCH® 6**. Immediately fill in the area fully troweling it flat and smooth. Remove excess from edges with a moist sponge.
- 6c. **FOR CRACK REPAIRS:** Rub **E-Z PATCH® 6** deep into crack and remove any excess with a moist sponge.

Allow overnight set before foot traffic or swimming.

To make a Custom Color with any of our cement type repair supplies, use any cement dye.
