

Bulk Scrubber Pads for Tile Grouting Using E-Z Patch® 22 Silicone Rubber

E-Z INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Fill the grout joint or crack in the grout full & deep with E-Z Patch® 22 Neutral Cure Silicone Rubber.
- **2.** Run finger or soft rubber trowel "float" over grout joints for 100% sealing to both sides of grout joint.
- **3.** Submerge the **Scrubber Pad** in water, pour some **Liquid Dishwashing Soap** on the Scrubber Pad and immediately scrub off all excess silicone rubber.
- 4. Any other clean-up may be done with a paper towel and rubbing alcohol or mineral spirits.

Do not allow liquid dishwashing soap or water to contact surfaces to be grouted prior to installing silicone rubber.

Do not allow Silicone Rubber to skin over before removing any excess with Scrubber Pads (about 1-5 minutes, depending on the temperature).

E-Z ANSWERS to some Frequently Asked Questions

- Silicone Rubber grouting is best done between 50 degrees F and 90 degrees F
- Silicone Rubber will skin over faster in hotter weather, slower in cooler weather
- Using Neutral Cure Silicone Rubber (E-Z Patch 22) is the best to use for flexible long lasting tile repairs
